

People always harmed wild animals because they were afraid of them. Some animals became extinct because people hunted them for different reasons. Nowadays, 1 animal species extinct every 20 minutes... 26% of mammals, 42 % of amphibians, 30% of sharks and rays and 13 % of birds are endangered. Human activities like massive use of fossil fuels, agriculture, intensive livestock farming, the use of fertilizers, overexploitation, massive destruction of forests cause global warming. That dramatically disrupts ecosystems. These changes have dramatic consequences on the fauna. For example: Polar bears need ice to feed. They can't hunt on the consequences ice. People destroy the African savanna so elephants lose their habitats. In Australla, kangaroos die by shovel, crushed by vehicles. Bees cannot find food because of overgrazing. Tortoises suffocated by plastic bags. People kill rhinos to sell horns or leopards for their fur.
